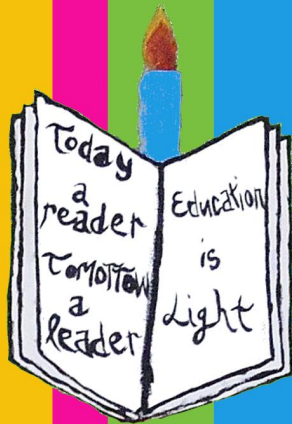

Hatua Likoni is a community NGO working to reduce poverty and unemployment in Likoni, Kenya. Through scholarships, mentoring and career guidance, Hatua helps Likoni's top students gain the skills, credentials and networks they need to contribute to and benefit from Kenya's growing economy.

There is a great range of roles you can play as a Hatua volunteer.

If your interests lie in education, library services or project management, you can volunteer directly with Hatua.

Other volunteer opportunities through our partners in Likoni include teaching at a Primary school, assisting at an orphanage, doing public health outreach and coaching football.

We'll work with you to determine which role will best utilize your skills and where you'll be happiest.

Our volunteer program starts with a week-long orientation to introduce you to Likoni, Mombasa, the Swahili language and Coastal culture.

Volunteers stay at Pungu Villa, our volunteer house overlooking the Indian Ocean, or can opt to stay with a local family in Likoni.



Costs

Orientation - \$385

Airport transfer, accommodation, food, transport, language lessons and city tours

Each week thereafter - \$240 / week

Accommodation (breakfast, dinner and housekeeping), Volunteer Coordinator and Program contribution*

*Program contribution of \$50 / week is managed by the volunteer in consultation with program staff to implement a project the volunteer believes meets a need within the organization where they are serving

Volunteers are responsible for their airfare, visa, daily transport, lunch and leisure expenses.

100% of income earned by Hatua through volunteer accommodation is re-invested in our programs on behalf of youth in Likoni.
